LESSON PLANS

Appear on Compass for each timetabled class and outline. All lesson plans follow a specific format and will include the following:

- 1. Learning Goal**
 - Explains what the purpose of the lesson is
- 2. APK (Accessing Prior Knowledge)**
 - Includes an image and an question to help students think about what they already know about the topic
- 3. New Knowledge**
 - Reading or activities that gives new information about the topic and explain how to use this
- 4. Application**
 - Activities to give students practice at using the skills that have been presented
- 5. Goal Review**
 - Student thinks about how well they have understood the task/s and how much effort they have put in to completing the task

READING

Different subjects will have different amounts of reading that is required.

- 1. Read the lesson plan instructions with your student:**
 - Discuss what is written and what students are being asked to do
 - Ask student to explain what they think needs to be completed
- 2. Read aloud any information that comes with the lesson with your student:**
 - Look up any unfamiliar words in the reading and discuss with your student
 - If you are unsure of what is being asked contact the subject teacher to clarify

WRITING

All work will be online but writing is an essential part of student learning.

- 1. Encourage students to write in full sentences that include:**
 - If answering a question, the question should be included in the answer
 - Evidence should be included to demonstrate the answer
 - Explain the reason they have given the answer
 - Start every sentence with a capital letter
 - Use a capital letter for the names of people, specific places or things
 - Finish each sentence with a full stop.
